## CONSTRUCTION QUALITY MANAGEMENT FOR CONTRACTORS

**U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps)**, San Francisco District, in partnership with the **Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC)**, and Associated General Contractors of America San Diego Chapter (AGCSD), is offering the Construction Quality Management For Contractors.

**This course is geared towards achieving construction quality.**

The mutual goal of the Contractor and the Government is to achieve a quality product, safely, on time and within budget. Quality management succeeds through a partnership between the Contractor and the Government. The contractor is responsible for the daily quality of the work, while the Government Quality Assurance helps ensure that the contractor's quality control program is effective. Scheduled goals are achieved through proactive contractor leadership that "builds it right the first time" avoiding costly reworks.

Effective quality control supports worker pride, results in favorable recognition, and has the potential to increase the profit margin for contractors.

### Course

The course offers prospective quality control managers / representatives the opportunity to satisfy the CQM training requirement specified in most Corps and NAVFAC construction contracts and must be taken and passed by any contractor aspiring to do work for us on projects of roughly \$1 million or more, within 45 calendar days after contract award. The contractor quality control (CQC) requirements and the Governments Quality Assurance (QA) role are reviewed. A course certificate will be awarded to those who satisfactorily complete the training and pass the final exam. The certificate will be good for 5 years, and is good for both Army and Navy projects.

The course is coordinated by AGC San Diego using experienced facilitators and Instructors to present information and materials needed to pass the exam and understand the requirements and receive the certificate.

The Cost is \$329.00, and includes all course material, breakfast, lunch, and breaks. Course length is 16 hours (2 days).

This two-day class provides Quality Assurance as well as Quality Control personnel the policy and procedure used in post-award construction. This instructional program has been designed, prepared and reviewed to provide live presentation, with interactive team breakouts and hands on reporting and meets all military requirements for certification.
